



Student Financial Status Check

All students subject to immigration control must satisfy the conditions set out by UKBA regarding financial support during their period of study in the UK. Once a course has been selected and an application form received the following documents must be sent along with each application

Copy of evidence of funds (e.g. Bank statements, Loan letter) conforming to the required amounts for obtaining a Tier 4 Visa. Check against the list of financial institutions published by UKBA for a particular country.

Students will have to show evidence that they have:

STUDENTS APPLYING FROM OUTSIDE THE UK

For courses of duration 9 months or less

- The full course fees
- at least £800 per month for each calendar month of the course

E.g. for a Certificate in Leadership and Management Course lasting 9 months. Course Fees £3,000 plus (£800 x 9) £7,200 maintenance amount. The total amount that the student must have available will be £10,200.

For courses of duration greater than 9 months, a student must show that they have:

- The first year's fees
- £7,200 to cover the living costs for nine months

STUDENT APPLYING FROM WITHIN THE UK

For courses of duration 9 months or less

- The full course fees
- at least £1,600

E.g. for a Certificate in Leadership and Management Course lasting 9 months. Course Fees £3,000 plus (£800 x 2) £1600 maintenance amount. The total amount that the student must have available will be £4600, unless the tuition fees have been paid to the College prior to the issuing of the CA, then the student would only have to show his/her maintenance money.
